RENEWAL OF BAPTISMAL PROMISES

P. Brothers and sisters in Christ, it is appropriate on this day of the Baptism of Our Lord Jesus Christ that we remember and renew the vows once spoken at our baptisms -- that time when we were washed of our sins and received the Holy Spirit to dwell within us. Let us boldly make our confession of faith before God, renouncing our sins and godlessness and embracing the godly life granted to us by the Spirit through water and the word. I ask you to profess your faith in Christ Jesus, reject sin, and confess the faith of the church. Do you renounce all the devil and all the forces defy God?
