LSS – Senior Nutrition

The focus of the Senior Nutrition program is to assist Minnesota's older adults to remain healthy, active and live independent lives. The Program has several ways of providing meals for seniors: Congregate meals at a senior center, Meals on Wheels for seniors who have a difficult time getting to a congregate meal site, and the Diners Club program which offers books of tickets for meals at local cafes and restaurants that have set up a special menu for the seniors.

1/3 of the funding for this program comes from State and federal government, 1/3 from customer donations, and the remaining 1/3 from fundraising, grants and donations from individuals and businesses.
